That is my praise for God. I will wear those experiences like a necklace around my neck.


It is honestly the most amazing feeling in the world to share Jesus' Love with others. I'm still a sinner everyday and I am still a desperately wicked doubting Thomas.


Have you had an experience since camp you'd like to share, small or large? Would you like to thank God for something?

- 22. And they immediately left the ship and their father, and followed him.
- 23. And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.
