Jesus is here telling them to start at Jerusalem first, right where they were.

They were not to travel over to Rome or India or Africa to be missionaries for Him. That would come later. They were to start in their very own home town.

Similarly, Mrs. White tell us to "take up the duty that lies nearest. First of all is the work in the family; next they should seek to win their neighbors to Christ, and to bring before them the great truths of this time." RH April 23, 1901 par. 2

I want to leave you with this encouraging quote:

"A soul saved in your own family circle or in your own neighborhood, by your patient, painstaking labor, will bring as much honour to the name of Christ, and will shine as brightly in your crown as if you had found that soul in China or India." Our Father Cares, p. 35

PLAN.

A plan consists of:

- Know it is God's will for you sanctification.
- Comitt to making it a life habit .
- Begin with familiar verses or short simple verses, always including references.
- Dont overload yourself with too many verses at once, give yourself time to meditate on every verse memorise.
- Set the same time and place every day to memorise, eg make it part of your regular morning worship.
- Always pray before memorising. Claim John 14:26
- Memorise aloud, have an accountability partner to recite to once a week.
- Learn word perfect including the reference. Say reference, then verse, then reference again. (Sandwich style)


**Motivating
