Corrie Ten Boom said, 'This is what the past is for, every experience God gives us, every person He puts in our lives is the perfect preparation for the future that only He can see.'

I've found this to be true of my experience at music camp. I met many beautiful, inspiring Christian's. Among them was the 'bible memory' lady (Mrs. Godfrey) who inspired us to grab a verse, learn it, love it and live it.

While recalling a verse during the day and trying to remember the words, I am delighted with new insights. Recently, I found the most encouraging and exciting verses to memorise and would like to share them with you.1 Samuel 12:20-22 (the context- The Israelite people had asked Samuel for a king)Then Samuel said to the people, "Do not fear, you have done all this wickedness, yet do not turn aside from following the Lord, but serve the Lord with all your heart. And do not turn aside, for then you would go after empty things which cannot profit or deliver, for they are nothing. For the Lord will not forsake His people, for His great Name's sake, because it has pleased the Lord to make you His people."

As I thought about following Jesus, I remembered my husband who had a large capacity for work. He always worked efficiently and walked quickly. Sometimes, after work I would go to the shopping centre to shop and my husband would pick me up from there. I would sit and watch for him... see page 3.



And when he came, he would catch my eye from the entrance, then turn and walk quickly to the car. I would then quickly move through the people, with my eyes fixed on him, not being distracted by anyone or anything around or I would lose sight of him and not know where the car was in the car park.

I thought, this is how I must follow Jesus, with strong purpose and not being distracted.

In the past, I have often felt discouraged and hopeless because of my failings. But I was excited to consider the thought that God is telling me not to fear because He will never forsake me. He is always with me, not because of what I've done, but because of who He is, His character of love. He desires to make us His people, not being willing that anyone should perish.

So, in spite of what we've done in the past, let us not be discouraged or fearful. Let us not turn aside from following Jesus, and serving Him with all our hearts, for all other ways cannot profit or deliver. They are empty!

However, we are always free to refuse to yield to His call to prayer. A clear example of this is seen in Ezekiel. Israel had gone into great apostasy. (Ezekiel 22:17-29.) Israel justly deserved severe judgments from God because of her sins. However, God in His mercy sought for a man in Israel who would pray to Him for mercy that His judgments would be averted, but sadly the next verse records the words, "but I found none." Because no one was willing to pray for God to withhold His judgments God said in verses 31. "Therefore have I poured out mine indignation upon them." The salvation of souls begins with prayer.
