The Australian Border agencies are very strict and don't play games, but this is where God's hand played a massive part in my life when we arrived at Perth Airport. We had 20 bags all together. I was so nervous about going through security checks, because my mum forced us to watch Australian Borders. My heart was beating faster than every step I took. I wanted to run back.... but I couldn't. We started to line up in the queue so we could go through the customs. Then a border agent said "British people go to the left and everyone else to the right" at that moment I realised that we weren't going through customs. We were just going to walk past and not get stopped at all. Let me repeat myself we had 20 bags which had all sorts of things like; knives, a rice cooker, bedding, wooden spoons, kitchen utensils and many more which we needed on arrival whilst waiting for our shipped containers to arrive. We should have been stopped with the things we had in our bags. This man approached us and said " Wow so any bags, too many for us to go through." As you see in my story that God had a plan for my family to be here in Australia for a reason. God knew that this was a best decision for my family so we could spend more time together as a family.


